## Herman's Hermits starring Peter Noone July 6, 2010

As "Herman", the photogenic Peter Noone graced the cover of nearly every international publication including Time Magazine. He performed on hundreds of television shows and appeared with such luminaries as Ed Sullivan, Jackie Gleason, and Dean Martin. Over 60 million records sold with 20 top 40 hits including: "I'm Henry VIII, I Am," "I Can Take or Leave Your Loving," "A Must to Avoid," and "Listen People."

## Ides of March featuring Jim Paterik July 13, 2010

The Ides of March released their first single - "You Wouldn't Listen" in the spring of 1966. Having secured a recording contract with Warner Bros. Records, in 1970 the band released "Vehicle," which at the time became the fastest selling single in Warner's history. Between 1973 and 1990, The Ides went on an extended hiatus, during which Jim Peterik founded the band Survivor and co-wrote all of their platinum hits including "Eye of the Tiger." They reunited in 1990 and have are still touring.



## Rhythm Method July 20, 2010



Rhythm Method is a 70's and 80's classic rock band from Milwaukee, Wisconsin. The band has been a staple of the Milwaukee music community since its inception in 1992, and continues to be a top drawing act today. In a time where many cover bands leave things open to their own interpretations, Rhythm Method prides itself on authentically recreating the sounds of the selections they perform in great detail.

## Starship starring Mickey Thomas

July 27, 2010

In early 1979 Mickey Thomas was asked to join Jefferson Starship. After the completion of the group's lineup, Starship embarked upon an international tour in the 80s. Mickey Thomas spent most of the early eighties as the main vocalist of Jefferson Starship. From 1985 to 1989 the newly dubbed "Starship" scored some of its biggest hits. In 1990, Mickey changed the name to "Starship featuring Mickey Thomas;" touring has continued with this title.
